ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW Directory services ran satisfactorily during January, with no major problems.

After the QUIPU software upgrade to XT-QUIPU 8.3 on each DSA there were problems with the DUA user interface DE and with IDM. DE was rerouted to use a backup system. DE was fixed by UCL-CS and is now back in operation. However, IDM still remains inaccessible.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service.

At the beginning of January two new members of staff joined the directory and relay Support team at ULCC, Ronan Flood and Stan Grant.

The UKERNA JANET PoP at Telehouse is progressing and an 8Mbps link upgrade between Telehouse and ULCC has been ordered. It is now the intention to route the US international services via Telehouse, whilst leaving the European services routed via ULCC. This will provide a highly resilient network infrastructure to JANET's international access.

Monthly Report February 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW Directory services ran satisfactorily during February, with no major problems.

The DAD server was switched off as it was not used and there is no perceived user requirement.

It was noted that the "browser" facility available through the DE interface has not been working since the upgrade to QUIPU. This was investigated and fixed. However, as last quarter, IDM remains broken as there are no maintenance arrangements in place for this.

Some changes have been made in the root DSA as an initial attempt to reduce the NameFLOW-Paradise infrastructure dependence on a central highly available service. The changes made at this time are in the areas affecting the replication facility that the DSA provides. Other changes are being discussed.

Further information has been added to the info-server at DANTE's request.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

3. ISSUES

An operational email list has been set up (POPS@nameflow.dante.net) with external members now providing input to DANTE on the NameFLOW-Paradise Service. This has proved highly beneficial.

The 8Mbps JANET link to Telehouse as part of the additional resilience programme, is now installed. However there are problems with driving this link at 8Mbps. These problems are similar to the problems experienced with bringing into service the 8Mbps link to EMPB; we now suspect the DSUs to be at fault.

Monthly Report March 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW Directory services ran satisfactorily during March, with no major problems.

The following operational activities are noted:

A problem was diagnosed with the mailing-lists as the version of PP (which is is very old) does not understand MX records. This is worked around by adding records to /etc/hosts pointing the email host at the primary MX preference.

A significant number of login failures on the public-access DUA machine were noted. A modified TELNETD has been installed which includes an announcement message prior to the login prompt.

A cron job is setup to retrieve the latest NameFLOW-Paradise contacts list from DANTE's web-server, to make it available on our info-server. This involved writing a 'C' program to talk to their httpd.

After the NameFLOW-Paradise meeting in Salford, work is in progress with NEXOR to produce a version of the root context knowledge in "strict X.500" format, for anonymous ftp.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

3. ISSUES

The ULCC Dial-up Service has moved from the old X.25 based service to a new IP based service, with user account validation. Access to the NameFLOW-PARADISE DUA has been maintained by adding the "psuedo" username "de" with no password, on the new Dial-up Service. This new service is on a new telephone number, +44 171 816 0993; however, the old number, +44 171 405 4222, has also been moved to this new service.

Access to European IP networks has been badly affected by the new 8Mbps JANET EMPB link which has continued to give problems and the service has reverted to using the 2Mbps connection. It is now clear that any problems there may have been with the DSUs has been resolved and

investigation must now focus on the EMPB Telebit at the UK EMPB PoP. This situation is being discussed with EMPB.

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during May, with no major problems.

The following operational activities are noted:

- o The DSA Giant Tortoise has been configured to accept DAP/DSP binds only from a given list of Distinguished Names.
- o The DUA machine, fortnum, now collects full hostnames for telnet connections using "TCP wrappers", and it is intended that a summary of these by top-level domain (uk, nl, edu, etc.) will be included in future reports.
- o At DANTE's request, four FLDSA managers were asked to remove the "photo" attributes from their DSA entries; so far two have complied.
- o Slave-update on both DSAs is now done at scheduled times by a cron job, rather than by having "update on" set in quiptailor. Giant Tortoise slaves at 2AM, 8AM, 2PM, and 8PM; Ocellated Turkey slaves at 12.10PM and 12.10AM.
- o Some effort went into preparing a count of the DIT.

3. ISSUES

It has been noted by DANTE that the DSA operations statistics produced in the past contain unusually low figures for Getedb operations. It has been discovered that this stems from a development of QUIPU which was not reflected in the statistics summary tool, dsastats. At some point QUIPU was enhanced to allow Getedb operations to proceed in stages, rather than transferring an EDB as a single operation. These stages are logged as "Getedb slice" operations, rather than as Getedb operations. The figures produced by dsastats for Getedb operations count only full EDB transfers, presumably to DSAs running very old versions of QUIPU.

This problem has been reported to NEXOR support, and to Paul Barker. The response from NEXOR is that the logging file has changed for MessageWare Directory Server, and the dsastats tool will be changed accordingly. Paul Barker says he is waiting on a UKERNA contract to do some work, and fixing dsastats could come under that.

In the meantime, a count of the "Getedb slice" operations has been added to the DSA statistics by hand. This practice will continue for future reports, and the on-line summary files on the info-server for previous months have been similarly modified.

4. STATISTICS

Monthly Report June 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during June, with no major problems during prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- c=KR has been taken over by a new DSA, cn=Dragon.
- Looking at the list of rejected binds on the DSA Giant Tortoise, the four most common culprits each had more than 100 rejections. The appropriate DSA manager or postmaster was contacted to alert them to the restrictions on access to Giant Tortoise. Only one responded, with the information that his was a test DSA and not operational.
- Some preparatory work has been done on the info-server to free-up disk space prior to attempting to mirror files from SURFnet. The PARADISE/QUIPU source files and documentation have been recompressed using GNU zip rather than UNIX compress, gaining 6Mb. The WU-FTP server has been configured to perform on-the-fly compression, uncompression, and conversion from .gz to .Z.
- While trying to understand why the Gopher server was not uncompressing the original .Z files, and with the intention of allowing it to work with .gz files, version 2.1.3 of Gopher was installed and configured. Unfortunately this contained a bug which had to be diagnosed and fixed. As it turns out, the Gopher server requires access to a UNIX shell to perform decompression, which we prefer not to make available in the FTP area. Neither are we prepared to rewrite the server to avoid use of a shell, if that is possible. Therefore it has been set up simply to deliver the compressed files as-is.
- Various shell scripts have been written to provide more summary statistics in these reports.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

Public-access DUA unavailable, incoming telnet sessions rejected due to inetd problem caused by repeated bad telnet connections from a US host; required a reboot to clear. The postmaster at the US host was contacted, but was unable to shed any light on the problem.

3. ISSUES

Progress with the 93 pilot is hindered by delays in the delivery of software.

Organisations in Argentina, China, and Mexico have expressed an interest in joining the NameFLOW-Paradise Directory at the top level. As yet nothing concrete has come of this. The organisation in Argentina -- the University of Buenos Aires -- has previously contacted the PARADISE helpdesk in December 1993, but there seems to have been no progress made at that time.

4. STATISTICS

This is the first report in which statistics on telnet connections to the public-access DUA host, fortnum, are provided. These are included with the DUA usage statistics, and give a breakdown of connections and DUA logins to the machine by top-level domain (.uk, .nl, .edu, etc). Only the top ten domains are included in the report -- full figures are available on the info-server. The data are gathered using "TCP wrappers" to collect the full DNS hostnames of the originating machines. These are then used, where possible, to extend any truncated names in the login history file (wtmp) to their full form.

Monthly Report July 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during July, with one major outage during prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- As part of the pilot to transition the NameFLOW-Paradise Directory Service to use software compliant to X.500(93) standards, NEXOR Ltd have supplied version 0.9 of Messageware Directory Server, together with a time-limited licence. This will be used to provide DISP replication of the "root context knowledge". Preliminary installation and configuration has been completed.
- At DANTE's request, the statistics area on the info-server was reorganised, and statistics for DANTE's web server were included. This activity was in fact deliberately delayed until the start of August. Also, back-dated DUA statistics were produced, along with revised DSA statistics.
- It was noticed that one of the FLDSAs, cn=Axolotl, was missing the mandatory quipuVersion attribute. As a result, Giant Tortoise refused to spot-shadow the entry. The manager for Axolotl was contacted to fix the problem.

The Helpdesk service was somewhat disrupted this month due to hardware problems on a workstation used by the support staff. The faulty hardware was replaced. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

2. OUTAGES

Tue July 4 08:00 - 10:00 (2hrs)

All services "at risk", scheduled JANET network update

Thu July 6 03:21 - 10:02 (6hrs 41mins)

Public-access DUA unavailable, incoming telnet sessions rejected due to inetd problem caused by repeated bad telnet connections from a CA host. A reboot cleared the initial problem, but since the CA host was still trying to connect, a block was put in the upstream IP router. The network contact for the domain was informed, but could not help.

3. ISSUES

This month saw one severe and one minor outage due to a problem first noticed in May, which is assumed to be caused by a memory leak in XT-QUIPU. The DSA process grows until it consumes all free memory on the machine. The CRON process dies the next time it wakes up, because it is unable to acquire memory. Eventually the DSA process itself dies, and is not restarted because, of course, the DSA monitor runs as a CRON job...

We intend to implement a "cross-machine" monitoring mechanism, where each DSA machine will regularly poll the other, and will alert staff if the DSA or CRON process is not present on the remote machine.

The outage caused by runaway TELNET requests is identical to an outage from June 5th, and suggests that there is some network or TELNET implementation problem -- both of the offending hosts run Linux. There is little we can do about this problem other than react when it happens.

Due to reorganisation of IP subnetworks/Ethernet segments at ULCC, in accordance with UKERNA security measures, there may be a need to change the IP addresses of the two NameFLOW-Paradise machines, and/or a requirement to alter the operation of the info server. This issue will be discussed with DANTE prior to such changes being made.

Monthly Report August 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during August, with one major outage.

The following operational activities are noted:

- Following on from last month, further work was carried out on the configuration of MDS for DISP replication.
- A "cross-machine" monitor was written and is now running (see July issues).
- In coordination with the country manager for c=AU, the DSA Giant Tortoise was removed as a slaveDSA for c=AU@o=DMD, and as a relayDSA for some DSAs under c=AU@o=DMD. These DSAs were then removed from the accept_prefix list on Giant Tortoise.
- It was noticed that the DSA Ocellated Turkey was registered as a slaveDSA for c=RU; this was removed.
- The WUFTP server was upgraded to version 2.4.
- Helpdesk staff contributed a section for the NameFLOW-Paradise Annual Report, and proof-read the draft report.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

2. OUTAGES

Thu August 17 12:44 - 13:31 (47mins)

DSA Ocellated Turkey unavailable, stuck TCP port; intervention required to free the TCP port and restart the DSA

Sat August 26 02:02 - Mon August 28 13:23 (59hrs 21mins)

DSA Giant Tortoise unavailable, stuck TCP port; eventually cleared itself, possibly by reboot of machine at other end of connection; August 28 was a holiday in the UK

3. ISSUES

We have noticed a problem with the EDB for c=NZ that causes the DSA Ocellated Turkey to crash when trying to replicate this EDB. Details have been passed on to NEXOR support, and the c=NZ country manager has been informed. The problem appears to be some new and undefined object identifiers (oids) that have been added to an

entry in the EDB. While waiting for a solution, Ocellated Turkey has been reconfigured not to replicate c=NZ.

A different problem with the same results has long been the case with the c=IN EDB. This was put to one side for lack of time and facilities to properly investigate the situation, but this too has now been reported to NEXOR support, and to the c=IN country manager. This problem concerns null components (empty strings) in postalAddress attributes. Ocellated Turkey continues not to replicate c=IN.

Monthly Report September 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during September, with several major outages outside prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- The problem with c=NZ mentioned in August issues has been resolved: the "unusual" OIDs were removed from the organisation entry, and the DSA Ocellated Turkey now replicates c=NZ again.
- Looking at the results from the root-level probe that ULCC runs, seven FLDSAs appeared to be uncontactable (Bear/RU, Chinchilla/CH, Dorcan Gazelle/IL, Guinea Pig/HU, Long Moustached Owl/HK, Saki/EE, and Woolly Spider Monkey/BE). The relevant country contacts were emailed to explore the problems. At the time of writing, Bear/Dorcan Gazelle/Saki are still outstanding.
- Helpdesk staff participated in the two-day NameFLOW-Paradise meeting, held at ULCC.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

DSA Ocellated Turkey unavailable, stuck process; eventually cleared itself

Sun September 17 19:47 - 21:31 (1hr 44mins)

Thu September 21 04:18 - 09:15 (4hrs 57mins)

All services unavailable via Internet, IP router locked-up; router had to be power-cycled to clear problem

DSA Giant Tortoise unavailable, crashed process; also cron crashed, so DSA monitor failed to run; reboot required (this outage continued to October 2)

3. ISSUES

The problem with c=IN described in August issues is still outstanding. The country-manager for India will be contacted again and asked to fix the offending organisation entries.

In consultation with DANTE, it was decided that the required reorganisation of equipment at ULCC mentioned in July issues would be most easily addressed by moving both NameFLOW-Paradise computers to a different IP subnet. This will require changing the IP addresses of the machines, which will have to be done both in the Internet DNS, and in the Directory for the DSAs. This change will also have to be announced to FLDSA managers, since each FLDSA quiputailor will have the "parent" parameter set to Giant Tortoise. The change should not affect DSAs that are not FLDSAs, since even if they have "parent" set to Giant Tortoise, they would be unable to connect to it anyway after the May reconfiguration limiting access to authorised users. It is not known when this change will take place, since it depends on availability of router/hub hardware.

Monthly Report October 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during October, with several major outages outside prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- Argentina (c=AR) finally joined the NameFLOW-Paradise Directory, with masterDSA cn=Gorrion.
- The messages displayed by the public-access DUA server at login and logout were changed to announce that the DUA will be withdrawn in January 1996. That decision was made at the NameFLOW-Paradise meeting in September. The logout message includes pointers to some other public-access DUAs, and the URL for the list of public Directory interfaces maintained on DANTE's web server. The specific access points mentioned in the message were chosen with reference to the domain usage statistics of the NameFLOW-Paradise service (as in Appendix 3).
- In cooperation with DANTE and FLDSA managers, the Directory entry for each country was modified to include a labeledURI attribute pointing at a suitable web page for that country. Storing URLs/URIs in the Directory is the subject of a current Internet Draft.
- The presentationAddress of the FLDSA cn=Guinea Pig (master DSA for c=HU), was found to have been changed without Giant Tortoise having had a chance to pick up the new address. The DSA entry on Giant Tortoise was manually updated.
- A discrepancy in Quipu's use of the dspchaining tailor parameter was noted, between the default behaviour described in the reference manual and that exhibited by the DSA. This difference was pointed out to FLDSA managers, since it might significantly affect the performance and availability of FLDSAs.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

The problem with c=IN that has been ongoing for some time has still not conclusively been addressed. The country-manager has responded to requests to change the erroneous entries; unfortunately, Giant Tortoise has been unable to contact cn=Pelican since then, to perform a slave update.

Following on from the September report, to date there has been no response from the managers of the FLDSAs Dorcan Gazelle (c=IL) and Saki (c=EE), with regard to the availability of the DSAs. Saki appears to be simply unavailable; Dorcan Gazelle seems to be running on a machine behind a firewall router which blocks access to the DSA TCP port 17003. The managers have been e-mailed again.

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during November, with several major outages outside prime-time. There was an extended problem with X.25, covering most of October and November.

The following operational activities are noted:

- An experimental FLDSA, cn=Giant Panda, was registered. This is managed by a researcher at Northeastern University in China, who is looking into the possibilities of running X.500 services in CERNET, the China Education and Research Network. As will be seen from the helpdesk summary in appendix 1, significant help was given during the month. This included building a plain text version of the ISODE manuals, which is now available on the FTP server.
- The FLDSA for c=IL, cn=Dorcan Gazelle, is now available again (see October issues). With no response forthcoming from the DSA manager, the DNS hostmaster at the site was contacted. The router block on TCP port 17003 was removed the same day.
- A request from the c=SG country-manager to add a new FLDSA, cn=Arowana, was deferred until some testing could be done. This DSA will be a slave for c=SG, which is using the "non-standard" attribute type sectorName in its Relative Distinguished Names.
- X.29 terminal access to Giant Tortoise's machine was disabled, as there is no requirement for this.

In addition, there was a problem with a port on the X.25 switch to which Ocellated Turkey's machine connects. This port got stuck, resulting in there being no incoming access to, or outgoing access from, Ocellated Turkey via public X.25 or EuropaNET X.25. This outage lasted from 18:00 on Tuesday October 3 until 09:40 on Monday November 20. Access to the public DUA over these networks was also prevented, and this is reflected in the EuropaNET/PSS usage statistics for October and November (appendix 3).

3. ISSUES

There has been no resolution of the problems of accessibility of the FLDSAs cn=Pelican (c=IN), and cn=Saki (c=EE). The respective managers have been e-mailed several times, to no avail. Pelican has not been contactable since October 18, while Giant Tortoise was last able to contact Saki in April.

There is a question mark over the requirement to provide EuropaNET X.25 access to and from the first level DSAs.

Monthly Report December 1995

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during December, with one major outage during prime-time, and several outside prime-time. There was an extended problem with X.25, covering the latter half of the month; this continued into January.

The following operational activities are noted:

- As mentioned in the November report, the manager for c=SG requested that a new FLDSA, cn=Arowana, be registered, for future use as a slaveDSA for c=SG. After some testing, this was done; see Issues for further information.
- A new FLDSA, cn=Manfred Woerner, was registered. This has become the new masterDSA for o=North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), replacing Violaceous Trogon, which has therefore been removed.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

As in October/November, there was a problem with a port on the X.25 switch to which Ocellated Turkey's machine connects. This port got stuck, resulting in there being no incoming access to, or outgoing access from, Ocellated Turkey via public X.25 or EuropaNET X.25. This outage lasted from 05:04 on Wednesday December 13 until the end of the month, and on into January. Access to the public DUA over these networks was also prevented, and this is

reflected in the EuropaNET/PSS usage statistics (appendix 3).

3. ISSUES

The eDBinfo attributes of the new FLDSA cn=Arowana, replicating portions of c=SG from cn=Lion, use the "non-standard" attribute type sectorName. Definitions for this attribute type had to be added to the local oidtables in order to add the new FLDSA, because the RDN types in eDBinfo attributes are encoded as OIDs in DAP/DSP. DSAs that do not have the definitions will see sectorName as the numeric OID 1.2.702.1.1001.2.1.

As well as having the new FLDSA cn=Manfred Woerner, the Directory manager for NATO has reorganised its DIT, such that the subordinate entries of o=North Atlantic Treaty Organization are now in themselves organizations, rather than organizationalUnits. This is unusual, and does not comply with the example DIT structure in X.521 annex B, but is believed not to contravene X.500. However there may be "visibility" problems if DUAs expect DITs to be structured as per X.521 annex B. The Directory manager for NATO would also like to rename the top-level entry from o=North Atlantic Treaty Organization to o=NATO. He may raise both of these issues with the NameFLOW-Paradise community via the managers and forum mailing lists.

The issue of the accessibility of the FLDSAs cn=Pelican (c=IN) and cn=Saki (c=EE) remains outstanding.
