Monthly Report January 1996

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during January, with several major outages outside prime-time. There was an extended problem with X.25, continuing from December.

The following operational activities are noted:

- TELNET access to the public DUA was removed at the end of the month. Anyone trying to use the DUA via TELNET is instead presented with a message telling them to use an alternative national service. The intention to shutdown the DUA was announced in the monthly report for October.
- At DANTE's request, helpdesk staff participated in a two-day EuroSInet workshop to create an X.500(93) test suite, with a view towards using it during the proposed NameFLOW-Paradise test week in February.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

There was an ongoing X.25 problem from December, with a port on the switch to which Ocellated Turkey's machine connects. This port got stuck, resulting in there being no incoming access to, or outgoing access from, Ocellated Turkey via public X.25 or EuropaNET X.25. This outage lasted from mid-December until 14:20 on Tuesday January 9th. Access to the public DUA over these networks was also prevented, and this is reflected in the EuropaNET/PSS usage statistics (appendix 3).

3. ISSUES

Although TELNET access to the public DUA was disabled, X.29 PAD access and ULCC dialup access were retained for the short term, pending a decision concerning what should be done about them. The DSA Ocellated Turkey supports the DUA and the public LDAP server, as well as being the master DSA for l=Europe. Each of these functions must be discontinued or redirected before the DSA itself can be shutdown, in preparation for the planned transfer of the Giant Tortoise DSA onto this hardware.

The issues of the accessibility of the FLDSAs cn=Pelican (c=IN) and cn=Saki (c=EE), and of the uncommunicativeness of their respective managers, remain outstanding.

Monthly Report February 1996

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during February, with one major outage during primetime, and two major outages outside prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- The primary activity in February was the continued reorganisation of the NameFLOW-Paradise services, consolidating them onto one host computer. The masterDSA of l=Europe was changed from Ocellated Turkey to Inca Dove; the future of l=Europe is under wider consideration. ULCC dialup access to the DUA was redirected to UKERNA services; X.29 access was disabled, with a message suggesting use of alternative national services.
- Having offloaded Ocellated Turkey, the DSA was closed down, and its entry removed from the Directory. This left the machine (fortnum) free of services, so the opportunity was taken to move it to a different IP subnet, as had long been the intention: see Issues from the September 1995 report.
- The Internet FTP and Gopher servers were moved from mason to fortnum, as was the DSA Giant Tortoise. The existing servers and DSA were left running in parallel for a period to allow time for the new addresses to propagate through the DNS and the Directory.
- FLDSA managers were informed of the changed DSA address, since they need to manually update out-of-band references to Giant Tortoise, such as the quiputailor "parent" parameter. Administrators at GARR in Italy, which holds a mirror copy of a portion of the FTP data, were informed so that they could amend their shadowing procedure -- it was using the IP address rather than the DNS name of the server.
- All DSAs which have access to Giant Tortoise, primarily FLDSAs, were checked to ensure that they had
 received a root EDB update prior to the original Giant Tortoise being closed down. This happened mostly
 automatically, but certain managers were contacted to remind them about this, in cases where their DSA was
 either uncontactable or appeared not to be replicating. Some FLDSAs are likely not to have the new address
 for Giant Tortoise -- the situation will be monitored.
- The public-access LDAP daemon was upgraded from Nexor v3.1 to v3.2 from the University of Michigan. Since the remaining DSA, Giant Tortoise, is not intended to resolve user queries, the LDAPD is actually supported by DSAs belonging to UKERNA -- see Issues.
- After much discussion, the FLDSA for NATO was renamed from cn=Manfred Woerner to cn=NATO.dsa. The organisation entry was renamed to o=NATO from the full-form o=North Atlantic Treaty Organisation. The change to the internal NATO DIT, mentioned in December 1995 Issues, was reversed, so that subordinate entries are organizationalUnits again.
- Helpdesk staff participated in the NameFLOW-Paradise X.500(93) pilot testing week, concentrating on DISP replication of the root context.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

3. ISSUES

After the reorganisation of services, the Sun 4/330 machine is left running only mail software, supporting the infoserver and the NameFLOW-Paradise mailing lists. As agreed with DANTE, the infoserver will be shut down, but the lists cannot be moved without cooperation from other staff at ULCC; it is hoped that the move can be completed, and this machine finally shut down, early in March.

As mentioned elsewhere, the LDAP daemon is being supported by UKERNA DSAs, and is being used primarily by DANTE's web gateway. It is felt that this situation should not continue without explicit authorisation from UKERNA.

4. STATISTICS

While the Giant Tortoise DSA was being moved, there was a change-over period during which there were two instances of the DSA running, on separate hosts. The DSA statistics in appendix 2 are the sum of the figures from both DSAs. The drop in the number of operations (searches etc) is due to the withdrawal of the public DUA, which used Giant Tortoise as a backup to Ocellated Turkey.

The huge increase in the number of LDAP connections happened because the LDAP daemon was upgraded, and is now being used to support DANTE's WWW/X.500 gateway. The previous version of the daemon could not interwork with the gateway, and so was not much used.

Access to the DUA via Internet was withdrawn at the end of January, and via dial-up and X.29 during February. The "DUA usage" figures in appendix 3 therefore mostly reflect attempted rather than actual use, and can be expected to continue to decline in future reports as people learn about and use the national access points.

The drop-off in FTP use is due to a change made at GARR in Italy, which mirrors part of the FTP directory daily. Originally the mirroring was performed simply by retrieving every file. Since early February, a proper mirroring tool is used, which retrieves only new or changed files.

Monthly Report March 1996

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during March, with one major outage outside primetime.

The following operational activities are noted:

- The reorganisation of services continued from last month: the mailing lists were moved to another machine, and the mail info-server was withdrawn. The parallel read-only copy of the DSA Giant Tortoise, which was left running to allow the new DSA address to propagate through the Directory, was shut down. Finally, the Sun 4/330 was powered-off.
- As a result of a helpdesk query, it was discovered that the "home" Gopher server at the University of Minnesota had a TELNET menu option pointing at the recently withdrawn public-access DUA. The Gopher team at UMN were asked to change this to the US public-access DUA at ds.internic.net.
- At the request of the managers for c=IE and EUnet Ireland, the FLDSA cn=Corncrake was removed. This required changing the masterDSA of l=Europe@o=EUnet, which had been cn=Corncrake; this is now mastered by a DSA belonging to EUnet Germany.

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

2. OUTAGES

DSA Giant Tortoise unavailable, stuck Quipu process; automatically restarted

Wed March 27 11:00 - 11:55 (55mins)

UKERNA DSAs supporting LDAP server inaccessible, IP router problem; router reloaded; this outage will have hit DANTE's WWW/X.500 gatway

3. ISSUES

With the removal from service of the Sun 4/330 machine, there are now no DSA probes running at ULCC, since the probe software was licensed to that hardware. If central probes are still required -- they are considered useful -- then this situation needs to be addressed, perhaps in consultation with UKERNA.

4. STATISTICS

Statistics for the mail info-server are no longer produced, since the server was withdrawn at the start of the month. Requests to the mail server are instead directed to the helpdesk, and will be logged as helpdesk queries.

As with last month, the DSA statistics are the sum of the figures from both copies of Giant Tortoise, although parallel running lasted only a couple of days.

3. ISSUES

There are ways around the problem caused by the unavailability of an IP router between the LDAP server and the UKERNA DSAs which support it (see Outages). However, the router in question is also the path to the wider Internet for the UKERNA machines, so if it crashes, access to organisational data will be severely limited. It is possible that in future the machines will be configured to run 'gated', to be able to take advantage of alternative routes.

The new disk for the SPARC-10 machine was delivered to ULCC at the end of April. Despite some misleading documentation from Sun, this should enable mirroring of software from SURFnet, and a rearrangement of log files etc.

4. STATISTICS

This month sees a further sharp decline in attempted use of the withdrawn public-access DUA. It is assumed that this results from the change to the "home" Gopher menu at the University of Minnesota mentioned in the report for March.

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during May, with one major outage during primetime and four outside prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- A problem with the FLDSA cn=Margay was pointed out to the managers for c=DE. The DSA's local copy of its own entry had lost the mandatory quipuVersion attribute, which prevented Giant Tortoise from shadowing the entry.
- The FTP server has been configured to mirror X.500-related software from a SURFnet server, as an interim measure prior to arranging mirror agreements directly with the relevant master servers. Mirroring from SURFnet had been agreed for quite some time, but implementation was postponed until more disk space became available, as mentioned in last month's Issues. Initial requests for mirroring have been sent to two sites, Bunyip and Groupe Bull, which are not mirrored by SURFnet.
- Helpdesk staff assisted DANTE in the preparation of the latest NameFLOW-Paradise publicity brochure.

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during June, with one major outage during primetime and one outside prime-time.

The following operational activities are noted:

- A new country, Malaysia (c=MY), together with its FLDSA Rimau (Malay for tiger), is in the process of joining the Directory. The entry for cn=Rimau has been added to the top level of the DIT, but c=MY has not yet been added, as the connection to Rimau is affected by a low-level network problem. An IP router in Malaysia appears to be behaving strangely, and this is under investigation in MY.
- An FTP mirroring agreement was set up with a server in the USA belonging to Groupe Bull, which holds copies of draft ISO documents. A request to establish a mirror of whois++ software from Bunyip was refused, due to the imminent release of a new version of Digger; Bunyip wish to monitor downloads.
- A count was prepared of organisations and DSAs in the Directory Information Tree (DIT).

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

3. ISSUES

The researcher in the Peoples' Republic of China who has been running an FLDSA experimentally for c=CN (see November 1995 report), has expressed an interest in registering c=CN in the NameFLOW-Paradise DIT proper. Technical issues aside, this is a matter for discussion between DANTE and CERNET.

The US manager is looking at X.500(93) under the auspices of the Challenge97 project of the World Electronic Messaging Association. This should eventually lead to the US FLDSAs converting to X.500(93) implementations, although there is as yet no timescale for this.

The European Space Agency has established an X.500(93) DSA internally, and is interested in connecting to NameFLOW-Paradise again. Rather than resurrecting the existing entry under l=Europe, because of the uncertain future of that part of the DIT, it is expected that ESA will be registered directly under the root, like NATO.

ACTIVITY REPORT

1. OPERATIONS/HELPDESK

The NameFLOW-Paradise Directory services ran satisfactorily during December, with no major outages.

The following operational activities are noted:

- An incorrect zone reference in DANTE's DNS configuration was corrected. This mismatch had been causing a problem with the LDAP statistics, due to inconsistent reverse lookups.
- The mailing list osi-ds@cs.ucl.ac.uk was removed, and forwarding was set up from osi-ds and osi-ds-request to forum and forum-request@nameflow.dante.net

No major problems to report on the Helpdesk service. A summary of the Helpdesk tickets is attached in the Appendices.

2. OUTAGES

Mon December 2 15:13 - 15:52 (39mins)

DSA Giant Tortoise unavailable, stuck Quipu process; reboot required to clear

The partial power outage scheduled for Tuesday 10th December and announced on the managers mailing list did not in fact take place: power was rerouted around the UPS during the safety inspection.

3. ISSUES

A new telephone system is being installed at ULCC, which will require the helpdesk contact number to change. ULCC's old main reception number will be retained with a recorded message advising the caller to ring the new reception number. It is not yet clear what the new helpdesk number will be, or whether this will get directly to the NameFLOW helpdesk, or to a generic helpdesk shared with other ULCC support functions.
